



# YOUTH SPACE RULES

1. Hej! is an open Youth Space for people aged 10-30. Hej! is available for a minimum of 32 hours per week, from Monday to Friday, between 12:00 PM and 8:00 PM.
2. The staff of the Hej! Youth Space does not provide childcare services for minors aged 10-17. Individuals in this age group may stay in the space with the consent of their parent/legal guardian, based on a previously completed declaration.
3. In Hej!, everything available in the space may be used as intended. Items, equipment, furniture, or food may not be removed from the space.
4. Hej! follows monthly and weekly schedules that provide information about space availability and activities taking place.
5. Individuals using the space are required to maintain cleanliness, take care of the equipment, and show respect toward others in Hej!.
6. Hej! is a space free from political and religious agitation as well as all types of intoxicants.
7. In case of high demand for playing on the PlayStation console, users are required to establish a rotation system that allows everyone interested to participate. Game time should not exceed 30 minutes.
8. Anyone interested can reserve the Hej! space for their own initiatives, projects, meetings, or other activities. Reservations can be made via email at [hej@lublin.eu](mailto:hej@lublin.eu) or directly with the space staff. Space reservations for the following week must be submitted by Thursday of the preceding week.
9. Individuals who exhibit inappropriate behavior, such as using vulgar language, arguing, physical aggression, damaging property, hindering others from using the space, or bringing/using intoxicants, will be asked to leave. If a person repeatedly violates the rules, the staff has the right to restrict their access to the space for up to seven days.
10. The Hej! Youth Space staff is not responsible for any items brought into or left in the space.
11. Any damages caused by a minor are the responsibility of their parent/legal guardian. An adult is fully responsible for any damage they cause.
12. The Hej! regulations aim to create a safe and friendly space. They may be subject to change depending on needs and circumstances.
13. Individuals who do not comply with these regulations or the equipment usage rules will be asked to leave the space.
