

Appendix No. 6 to the regulations of the "Municipal Youth Activator" programme

GDPR (RODO) information clause*

*The information clause is signed by:

- in the case of adult members of the youth group – independently;
- in the case of underage members of the youth group – a parent or legal guardian.

In the scope of protection and processing of personal data, the "Ulica Krótka" Association is committed to complying with and achieving the objectives set out in Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (OJ EU L 119, 2016). The personal data controller is the "Ulica Krótka" Association.

The Association will use the personal data of the Project Initiators for the following purposes:

1. conducting analyses and statistics for internal purposes related to the implementation and evaluation of the Municipal Youth Activator;
2. promoting the Municipal Youth Activator, including developing materials and publications and placing them on the programme's website;
3. evaluation of cooperation offers in terms of content and form within the project evaluation team with the composition specified in point 18 of the principles of cooperation;
4. announcement of the results of the recruitment of cooperation offers on the operator's website;
5. conclusion and implementation of the contract – Appendix No. 3;
6. promotion of the Municipal Youth Activator;
7. other purposes to which the Association is obliged under applicable law.

Access to personal data will be granted to authorized personnel of the Organizer and entities providing services to the Organizer (i.e. IT and technical support services, postal operator) who must have access to the data to perform their duties.

These entities will have access to data only to the extent necessary to perform their tasks.

The entity commissioning the task (Municipality of Lublin) may also have access to the data. The Organizer does not transfer personal data outside of Poland / the EU / the European Economic Area.

Personal data will be stored for the period required in the contract for the performance of the task. The Organizer has appointed a Data Protection Officer, who can be contacted regarding matters related to the protection of personal data and the exercise of one's rights by email: mam2026@ulicakrotka.com or in writing to the registered office of the "Ulica Krótka" Association (Ireny Kosmowskiej 1A/15, 20-815 Lublin)

People participating in the Municipal Youth Activator are entitled to:

1. request access to your personal data, rectification, erasure or restriction of processing, to object to processing, as well as the right to transfer data,
2. if the basis for the processing of personal data is consent – the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal,
3. lodging a complaint with the supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (Przemysław Celiński)

Data will not be processed in an automated manner, including profiling. Providing personal data is voluntary, but refusal to provide it will prevent you from participating in the Municipal Youth Activator.
