

Appendix No. 7 to the regulations of the "Municipal Youth Activator" programme

Principles for protecting the natural environment from negative effects.

In order to protect the natural environment from the negative effects of using disposable items made of plastic, the project promoter is obliged to:

- 1) eliminating the use of disposable plates, cutlery, cups, stirrers, sticks, straws and food containers made of polyolefin plastics in the performance of the contract and replacing them with reusable equivalents or disposable products that are compostable or biodegradable, including those made of biological plastics that meet the EN 13432 or EN 14995 standard;
- 2) serving refreshments without using disposable plates, cutlery, cups, stirrers, sticks, straws and food containers made of polyolefin plastics;
- 3) serving water or other beverages in biodegradable, reusable packaging or in returnable bottles;
- 4) serving tap water for consumption if the requirements for the quality of water intended for human consumption, as stipulated by law, are met;
- 5) use of materials that originate from or are subject to recycling in the performance of the contract;
- 6) refrain from using disposable packaging, bags, nets and shopping bags made of polyolefin plastics;
- 7) prohibition of using balloons with plastic sticks;
- 8) prohibition of releasing sky lanterns;
- 9) ban on the use of fireworks and firecrackers.
